# SMART Criteria

- Specific
- Measurable
- Action-oriented
- Result-oriented
- Time-limited

# Specific

- Group should focus on all the existing tools for finding international job opportunities in the field of environment (websites, newsletters, etc.)
- A synthetic document should be produced with a list of such tools to be spread to EFAEP members and published in the EFAEP website
- Some of the vacancies will be diffused through ENEP ("Job offers" subscribers), asking for a feedback from those who will apply

# Measurable

- The document should list at least 5 major tools that can be utilised for finding international job opportunities
- At least 10 job offers tailored for environmental professionals should be spread through ENEP
- At least 3 out of them successful (feedback required!)

# Action-oriented

- Members should focus on the specific targets assigned, and produce some very practical results

# Result-oriented

- Results should be spread to EFAEP members and ENEP subscribers, and reported in the EFAEP website

# Time-limited

- The synthetic document should be ready by September 2009
- It will be included in the last EFAEP Bulletin of 2009
- 10 job offers should be spread to ENEP subscribers by the end of 2009
