- EU White Paper on Climate Change to be published soon
- Copenhagen Climate Change Conference

Specific

3 actions planned:

1. Letter to MEPs making a statement on what needs to be done to slow down climate change
2. Position Paper on the White Paper
3. Letter to heads of state of EFAEP countries with EFAEP position on minimum reduction targets to be reached



Measurable

Publication and distribution among stakeholders of the three position papers mentioned above



Action-oriented

All three activities are closely related to current policy events

Result-oriented

The group will focus on the output of three publications. Success will be measured by the drafting and distribution of these publications

Time-limited

- First Action : EFAEP position for MEPs should be sent in **autumn** to welcome the new MEPs to the new legislative period (also beginning of Swedish presidency)
- Position on white paper should be published at the latest **three weeks after the publication** of the white paper by the European Commission
- Position for Copenhagen Conference should be sent out **shortly before the beginning of the conference**
